

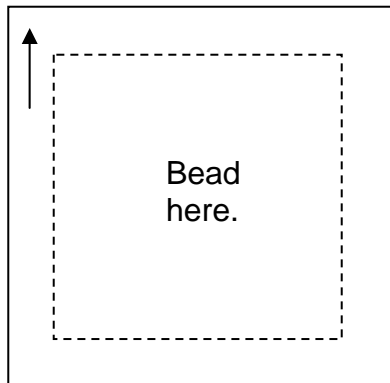
Ground Rules for the “Bead-It-Forward” Breast Cancer Donation Project

1. The completed square must be returned to me by **April 1, 2007**. If it is not received on or before the deadline, it will not be included in the project. Likewise, a square that does NOT conform to these guidelines will not be included.
2. The title of this piece is “Metamorphosed Like the Butterfly...”
3. You may use ANY beadwork stitches or techniques on your square, but the motif of the square must reflect **butterflies**. All beads and objects must be securely attached to the pella square with thread. Attaching beads or objects with glue or tape is not permitted, as it is not durable.
4. You may use any colors, shapes, or styles of beads on your square, providing the overall motif is **butterflies**. Just make sure that the quality is good and the square is aesthetically pleasing.
5. Cut a piece of white pella peltex 70 ultra firm stabilizer (available from fabric stores) into four 2-inch by 2-inch squares. In the center of each square outline with dotted lines a 1 ½ “ x 1 ½” square. See illustration below. If you have concerns about the white of the pella showing through the beadwork, color it with permanent markers first. Then bead/work your butterfly design to the **dotted** edge. This is very important, as it is difficult and/or impossible to sew squares together that are irregular in size.
6. Be sure to include an UP arrow in the margin. See illustration below.
7. Sign your name in permanent marker on the back of your **completed** square.
8. You will NOT know the appearance of the entire picture until the piece is done. That's the fun of this type of piece.
9. You agree to relinquish all rights to your completed square, except recognition/acknowledgment of your contribution to the entire piece. After Jeanette Shanigan completes the finishing, she will donate the entire piece to Bead Artists against Breast Cancer for their annual auction.
10. If possible, please bead-it-forward by giving the other 3 squares that you made in steps 5 & 6 and copies of this form to three bead buddies.

Print this form. As your printer may be different than mine, measure to double-check that the square's dimensions are accurate. During daylight hours, hold this paper up to a window. Put a piece of pella over the square and trace. Repeat three more times to bead-it-forward. Cut out the squares on the solid lines.
