

beaded heart motifs

A simple, versatile heart motif perfect for adding to your beadwork



Materials

- I used Miyuki Delica beads but do experiment

Tools

- Beading needle & thread of choice
- Thread of choice
- Scissors

Techniques

Knowledge of Looming or Square Stitch is needed for this project

A note on using these instructions

- I love to support and encourage individuals who make beadwork so please feel free to use anything you make from these instructions as gifts or to sell to support your bead buying habit!

The Motifs

These simple heart motifs can be repeated to form strips or panels of beadwork. Use the patterns for loom work or square stitch.

When beaded using Delica beads;

- Four motifs make a strip approximately $\frac{7}{8}$ of an inch by $4\frac{7}{8}$ inches
- Five motifs make a strip approximately $\frac{7}{8}$ of an inch by $6\frac{1}{8}$ inches
- Six motifs make a strip approximately $\frac{7}{8}$ of an inch by $7\frac{1}{4}$ inches

If you need to extend your piece you can add extra rows of plain beads at either end or between the motifs.
